## ANNUAL REPORT 2017-2018

The Training and Placement cell is an institutional arrangement in our college, which has the aim of offering various career and skill development trainings to the students. It also extends its service by providing suitable jobs to them, who are completing their studies from QMC.

The Cell comprises of two faculty placement Officers Dr. Razia Parveen, Head of the Department of History and Dr. M. Uma Maheswari, Head of the Department of Sanskrit and the Placement representatives (students) from each department under its umbrella. Ms. Jyothilakshmi, III B.A. English Literature and Ms. Salomi III B.Sc., Bio-Chemistry, Ms. Archana III B.Com (Shift 2) are actively leading the cell as student presidents.

This cell acts as an interface between various organizations, companies and the students. It brings successful personalities from different organizations to the campus to talk to young talents on various employment opportunities and placements.

Training and placement conducts orientation programmes, seminars, workshops and training courses to enable the students of our college to become successful professionals as self/social entrepreneurs. The cell also sends students to get trained in various PMKVY and TNSDC programmes that are conducted off campus by various institutions like CADD centre, synergy etc. 6 Batches comprising 12 Students and 1 faculty that includeds the Department of Mathave visited Barclays Bank in DLF centre, Chennai on various days for a live Live HR interaction sessions.

G.S. Skills Solutions conducted CSR Employability program sponsored by Barclays international and Laurez Edutech. 1262 students took part in Banking and Retail Management training and 16 trainers trained the students for 10days between July and August 2018.

NIIT Chennai and Rexona company Chennai came and gave an One Day Orientation Programme for 1000 students on Interview facing and Aptitude Exam.

Don Bosco Vazihikatti trained 800 students in communicative English and employability skills for 10 days during the month of January 2018.

Mr. Baskaran Krishnamoorthy Income Tax Officer Chennai motivated students on TNPSC Group IV Examination for 1000 students on January and gave One week special coaching for 80 registered candidates for Group IV examinations.

On January 31<sup>st</sup> 2018 through GS Skills Gen Solutions under CSR Programme from Barclays conducted a Campus drive with 7 companies. Don Bosco Vazhikatti and Quest Alliance under CSR Project of Bank of America brought 15 companies for Campus Drive on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2018. It has also short listed around 60 students from various other faculties for special training and placements during the month of May 2018, the results are awaited for the same.
