



ACTIVITIES

- This academic year the **Theatre and Public Speaking Workshop** was organised for students across disciplines of the Undergraduate Programme on the 2nd of February, 2023
- The Chief Guest was Actor CVSS Maanas.
- In the first session students of the Club demonstrated poetry in motion by enacting poems like *The Highwayman* and *Charge of the Light Brigade*.
