Day 1

16-12-21 FORENOON:

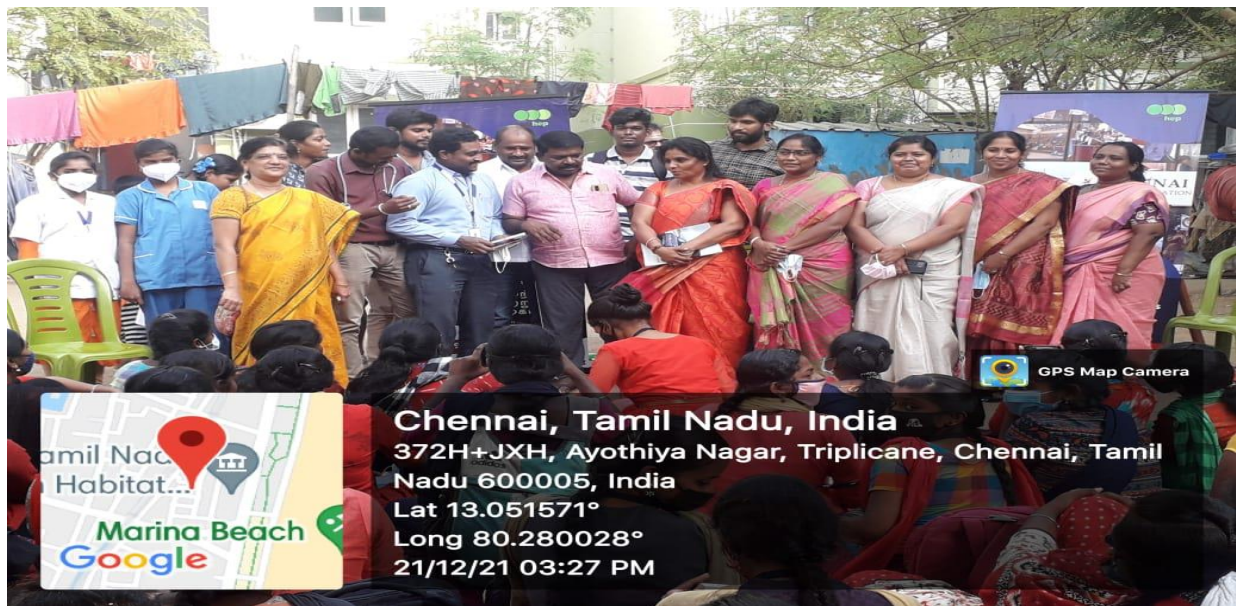




AFTERNOON:
